



How to Use HexaCubes

How to tell HexaCubes apart

Dice that are d8 and smaller are 'tall': 

D10 and bigger are 'wide': 

D6 and d10 are 'square': 

The others are 'diamond' (and are divisible by 4): 



A "tall diamond" d8

How to Use a HexaCube d20

A roll of 'blank' on the binary and a '1' through '9' on the d10 is a result of 1 through 9.

If you get a '1' on the binary and a 1 through 9 on the d10, the result is 11 to 19.

A binary '1' and d10 'zero' equals a '10'.

A 'blank' binary and a zero on the d10 is a '20' - much like rolling a '100' result on percentile dice.
